Executive Summary

This deliverable describes the content, structure, layout, management and hosting of the MOBiNET project website. The share of responsibilities among partners and further provision of information regarding the website are explained as well. The project website is the main gateway to exchange information on the project objectives, activities, and partners, including a library of reports and other publications, and links to other related initiatives. The website is also used to provide an entry point for registration to the MOBiNET Provider Community.

1. Website management

The MOBiNET website (<http://mobinet.eu/>) is developed and administered by VTT with the assistance of ERTICO. In addition to the administrators, the MOBiNET project partners can sign up and log in to the website to update the content (such as news items).

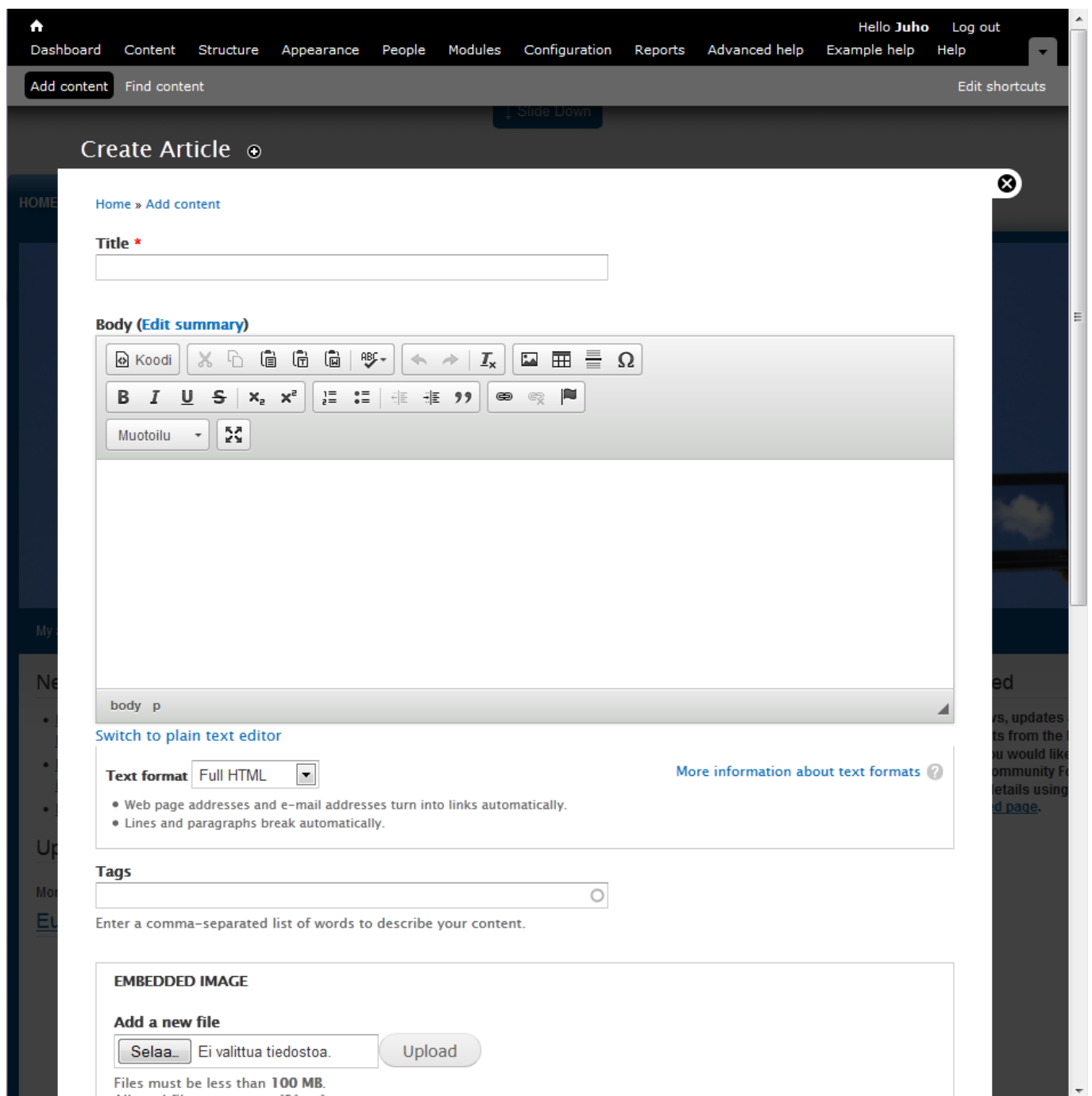


Figure 1. An example of adding content to the website via browser interface

The domain is hosted by a Finnish domain and hosting service provider *Suomen Hostingpalvelu Oy* (<http://hostingservice.fi/>). The website management, layout changes and content updates are done using a browser based open source content management system Drupal (Figure 1).

2. Website structure

The MOBiNET website consists of eight main sections that can be navigated to from constant links at the top of the layout (Figure 2). These sections are described in the following sections.

2.1. Home

The *Home* page of the project website is divided into three main sections. On the left, there are lists of topics with links to the latest news and upcoming events. The main section in the middle first presents a short summary about MOBiNET – the vision and goals. Below the vision, a few of the latest MOBiNET news items are displayed. In the third section, on the right, there is a brief invitation to get involved in with the MOBiNET Provider Community by registering to receive news, updates and announcements about the project.

To indicate that MOBiNET is funded by the European Commission under the FP7, the logos for EU and FP7 are also included at the bottom of the homepage (Figure 3).

2.2. MOBiNET – The Vision

The *Vision* section describes the MOBiNET concept and the main goals and objectives in the project. The description includes reasoning why MOBiNET is required, what are the key innovations that will be developed and what are the key features of the platform, namely being a multi-vendor business-to-business e-marketplace and enabling easy deployment and operation of services. Project partners are able to edit the contents when logged in to the website.

On the left side of the Vision section, the main components of the MOBiNET platform are listed with links to short descriptions about them:

- MOBiCENTRE,
- Service Directory,
- Identity Management,
- Privacy Management,
- Billing Management,
- MOBiNET Dashboard,
- MOBiAGENT,
- Service Provider Development Kit,
- Business Requirements, and
- The Provider Community.

2.3. MOBiNET – The Project

The *Project* section of the website provides basic information regarding the MOBiNET project. The information includes being co-funded by the European Commission (under FP7-ICT-2011-6.7), project coordinator contact and a list of the project partners, list of represented sectors (Figure 4), duration, and total budget. Project partners can edit the contents when logged into the website.

2.4. Publications

The *Publications* section provides information about and, where applicable, download links for all the public documents produced during the project. According to the different publication types, the section has the following sub sections:

- Deliverables
- Articles
- Presentations
- Media desk

Project partners can add items and upload files when logged in.

2.5. News

The *News* section can be edited by the project partners. The MOBiNET news include, for example, events where MOBiNET has been presented and information about other stakeholder events. The latest news items are also displayed on the *Home* page to make sure new updates are noticed.

2.6. Events

The *Events* section lists upcoming and past events related to the MOBiNET project, such as the ITS Europe Congress in Helsinki in June 2014. In addition to a list of the events, the section also has a visual calendar that displays the events. The events page can be edited by the partners.

2.7. Partner area

The *Partner area* section is where the project members can sign up and login to be able to edit the contents of the website and, for example, upload new content to the publications section.

2.8. Get involved

The *Get involved* section is where external stakeholders can register their information (name, organisation and email address) to receive news, updates and announcements from the MOBiNET project. Registration does not produce any automatic emails when new updates are done at the MOBiNET website. Registration produces a list of contact details that the MOBiNET partners can use when announcements should be sent to those who have shown interest.

The contact details of those registered through this section can later be used to contact potentially interested people when building the MOBiNET Provider Community.

3. Website statistics

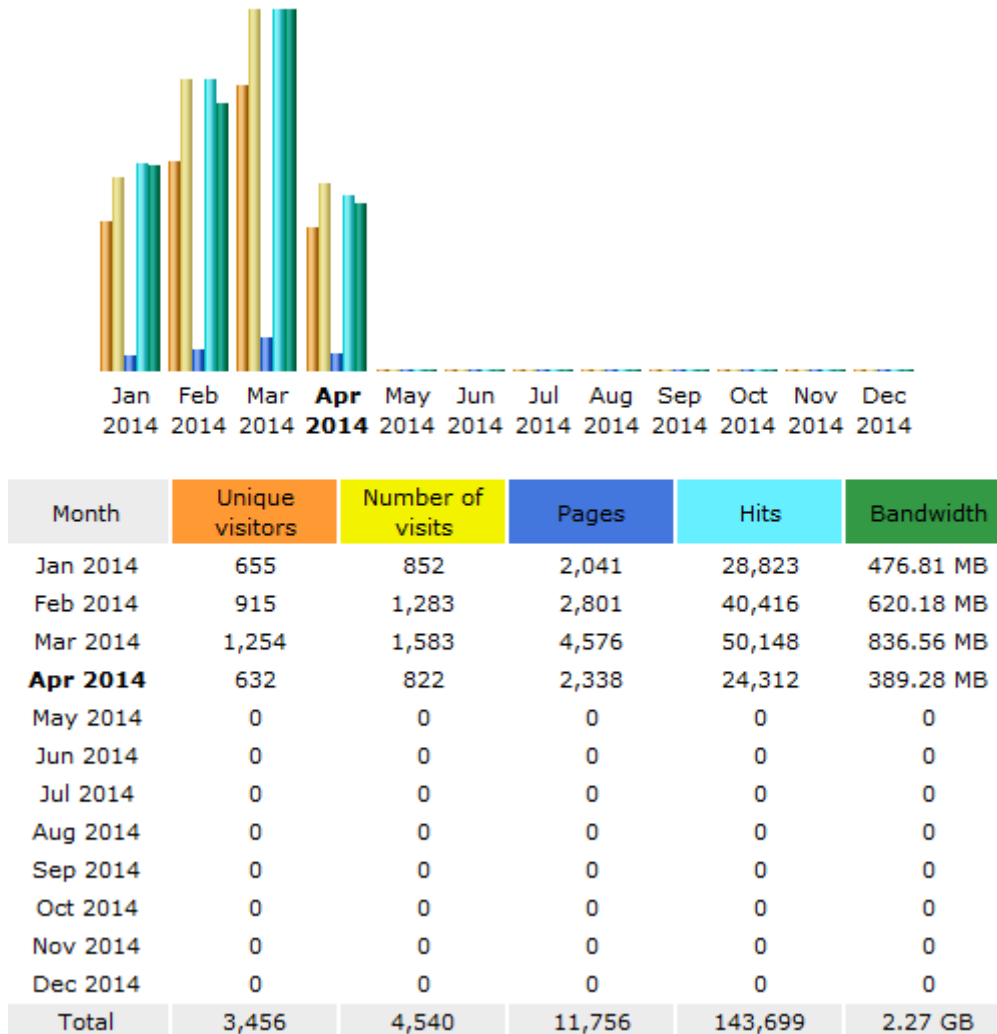


Figure 5. Example of website analytics by AWStats

The hosting service for the MOBiNET website includes an open source web analytics reporting tool AWStats (<http://www.awstats.org/>) which can be used to gather information about visits, page hits and unique visitors at the website (Figure 5).

In addition to AWStats, Google Analytics (<http://www.google.com/analytics/>) was incorporated in the MOBiNET site in April 2014, and will be used for analysing the traffic at the website later on.

The website statistics are reported as part of the periodic reports.
